
## **Directions to Warren Kruse Field**



Warren Kruse Field, the flying field of the Mercer County Radio Control Society, is easily accessible from Interstate Highway I-195 in New Jersey. I-195 runs east-west and connects with I-95, the New Jersey Turnpike, at exit 7A of the turnpike. Exit 11 of I-195 is about four miles east of the turnpike. From exit 11, follow Imlaystown-Hightstown Road through the first jogged intersection and 1.3 miles north to East Branch Road. Turn right and follow East Branch Road past the horse farm. At 0.6 miles, veer left at the ranger station onto East Eldridge Road and follow it to the intersection at Clarksburg-Robbinsville Road. Drive into the driveway of the abandoned white house across the intersection and make a right onto the dirt road. The field is to the left behind a row of trees. Total distance from the exit to the field is 2.8 miles. Note that only the essential roads are shown on the map.
